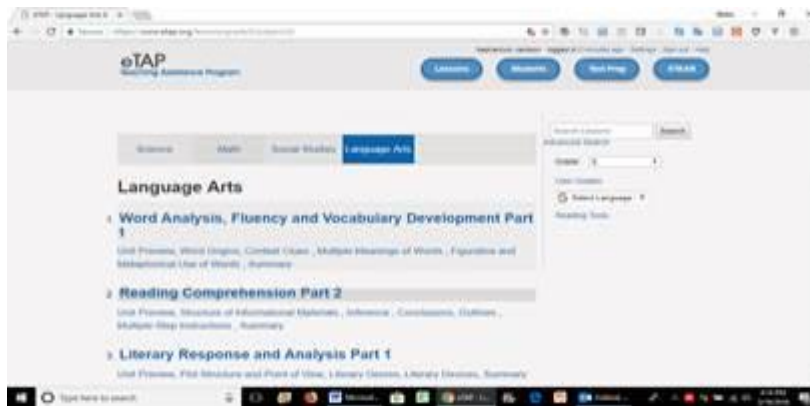

Teacher login.

1. Go to www.etap.org
2. [Sign in](#) with temporary user name **teacher2** and password **demo**



You can select grade and subject. Next select lesson you would like to edit.

Editing software - you will see [Create Custom Version](#) located above lesson title on left side.

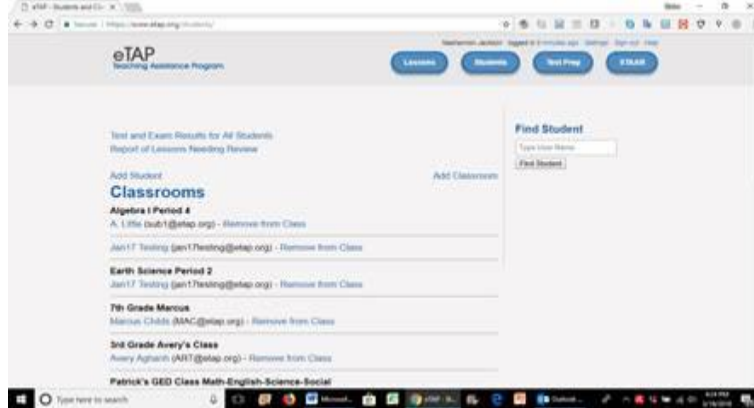


When you click on [Create Custom Version](#) you can easily do editing by using word commands. Only students in your classes will see the edited content.



Addition of students by teacher.

1. Go to the **Students** button at top of page.
2. Click on **Add student** as shown below above Classrooms on Left side of page.



Records of students

1. Click on student name at left and the following records can be selected: **Test Scores - Course Progress - eTAP Transcript - Login History**
2. Also, above Classroom, records of all students as a group the following can be selected at the top of page: **Test and Exam Results for All Students** and **Report of Lessons Needing Review** with the lesson and standard identified.
